The issues below were recorded in a Village Meeting to discuss the TAG report. The TAG Group now proposes that these issues are incorporated into the report as Appendix 3 and should be taken into account when planning future actions.

- 'Raised crossing points don't slow traffic down but they do make a lot of noise' particularly when vehicles with trailers hit them.
- Some 'Rs' expressed general concern when crossing the road near the 3 Kings r/b
- Several 'Rs' expressed concern about increased use of the B1106 by HGVs
- One 'R' asked whether there were plans to measure pollution levels due to the high volume of vehicles at the 3 Kings r/b
- One 'R' suggested traffic lights on the avenue of Oaks to moderate the traffic flow.
- Several 'Rs' expressed concerns about the narrow footpath near the 3 Kings r/b and leading to the crossing point for the community centre. Far too narrow for a wide buggy and children in tow (with a dog sometimes)
